Eastern Michigan University's College of Technology

Undergraduate Awards:

- ♦ **Grace Fuller Endowed Scholarship**— (Dean's Office) Junior or Senior in IDE, ATM, HRM programs with minimum 3.0 GPA and selection based upon scholarly performance and leadership potential.
- ♦ **John and Lois Porter Presidential**—(Dean's Office) Awarded to juniors/seniors majoring in ATM, HRM, or IDE with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Selection based up scholarly performance and leadership potential. Financial need may be the determining factor between equally qualified candidates.
- ♦ **Frances G. Sanderson Endowed Scholarship** - (Dean's Office) Undergraduate in IDE, ATM, HRM programs who demonstrates leadership ability, personal motivation and commitment along with scholastic performance.
- ♦ **Richard & Norma Sarns Scholarship** – (Dean's Office) Awarded to College of Technology students having a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- ♦ **Jay J. Seaver Scholarship** – (Dean's Office) Awarded to College of Technology juniors/seniors who exhibit superior academic performance.
- ♦ **Fred C. Wright** – (Dean's Office) Awarded to juniors/seniors enrolled in the construction management program with a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- ♦ **ALS/ Wade McCree Scholarship** – (SET) Awarded to African-American male students who qualify for the Wade McCree program.
- ♦ **Ervin Industries Scholarship** – (SET) Awarded to freshmen/transfer students majoring in Industrial Technology.
- ♦ **John C. Graham Memorial Scholarship** – (SET) Awarded to Polymers & Coatings majors having a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- ♦ **IFMA - Southeastern Michigan Chapter Expendable Scholarship**– (SET) Awarded to Facility Management majors with preference given to students who are enrolled full time, have junior or senior status and have little or no other financial aid.
- ♦ **The Lilly Industries, Inc. Scholarship** - (SET) Awarded to full time students majoring in Polymers and Coatings with a 3.0 GPA and junior standing. Must work at Lilly Industries, Inc. during the summers following Sophomore and Junior years.
- ♦ **Charles H. Parker Scholarship** - (SET) Awarded to students in the Polymers and Coatings curriculum.
- ♦ **Virginia Seaver Endowed Scholarship** - (SET) Awarded to the student who places first in the junior review process in the interior design program.
- ♦ **Carolyn Marr Thomson Scholarship** - (SET) Awarded to CAD/CAM majors having a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- ♦ **College of Technology Coatings Scholarship** - (SET) Awarded to Polymers and Coatings majors having a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- ♦ **Dr. John A. Weeks Scholarship** – (SET) - Awarded to Construction Management majors who are members of Eastern Constructors, the American Inst. of Constructors and have earned a minimum 48 credit hours toward a CM degree by app. deadline.
- ♦ **Polly and Jim Buchanan Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to a hospitality management program major at or above sophomore (25+ cr. hrs) including graduate students with a minimum 2.3 GPA and demonstrates an interest in hospitality industry. (One time recipients.)
- ♦ **Coca Cola Endowed Scholarship**— (STS) Awarded to students with a minimum of 56 credit hours, having completed their first HRM cooperative study and are in good academic standing. Financial need may be considered.
- ♦ **Mary Cullen Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to Communication Technology majors having a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- ♦ **Rhona M. Gayleard Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to Business Education majors having a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- ♦ **John Rini / AMS Detroit Area Chapter Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to juniors/seniors majoring in an administrative management area. Show evidence of leadership and service and membership in EMU Administrative Management Society.
- ♦ **McNamara Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to Aviation students who have a GPA of 3.0 or above and who reside in Wayne County.
- ♦ **Julius M. Robinson Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to Business Education juniors/seniors (75+ hours) having a GPA of 3.0 or above.
- ♦ **Technology Solutions**– (STS) Awarded to Junior/Senior Communication Technology majors with a minimum 2.7 GPA with preference given to Technology Solutions employees. Recipients are encouraged to participate in internship while receiving scholarship.
- ♦ **George A. Willoughby Memorial Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to Industrial Education majors.
- ♦ **Dr. Rose C. Wingo Scholarship** - (STS) Awarded to Business Education majors with minimum 2.5 GPA, who have completed BEDU200 and expressed in writing a desire to become a teacher.
- ♦ **Army ROTC Scholarship** – (MSL) Awarded as a two-, three-, and four-year scholarship to qualified students in any academic department who have a GPA of 2.5 or above.

Graduate Awards:

- ♦ **Associated General Contractors of America Scholarship** – (SET) Awarded to Industrial Technology graduate students. Awardees are required to participate in the development and implementation of a survey targeting the AGC Greater Detroit Chapter's membership needs.
- ♦ **Gamma Alpha Chapter Delta Pi Epsilon Scholarship** – (STS) Awarded to graduate students who have a GPA of 3.5 or above and who have completed at least 15 Master's hours, with at least 6 hours consisting of Business Education courses.
